



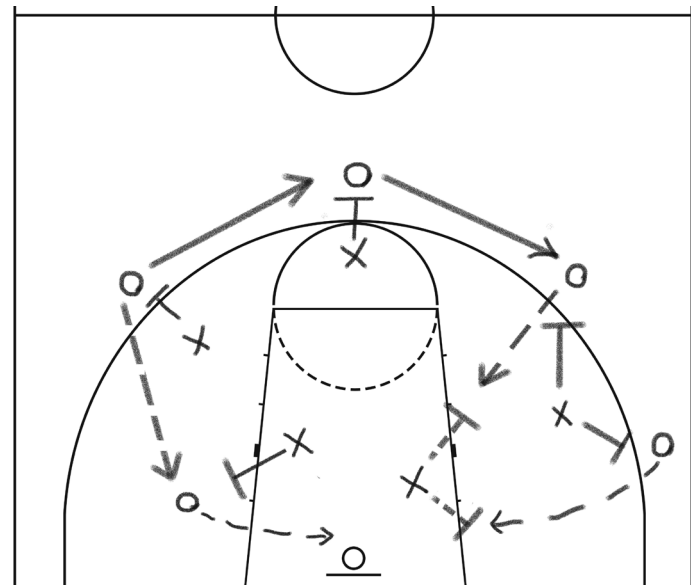
Team Empowerment in Safety
